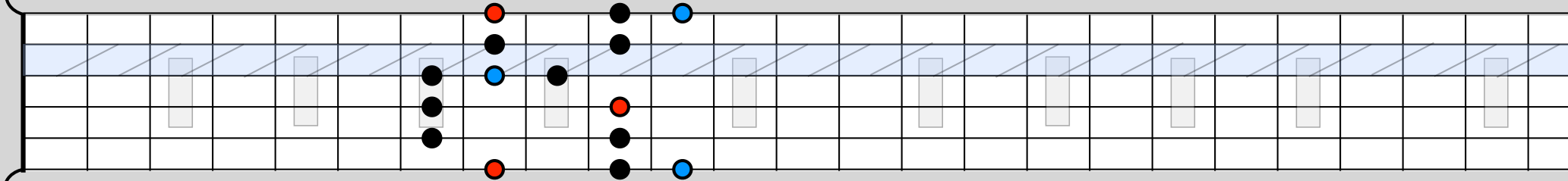

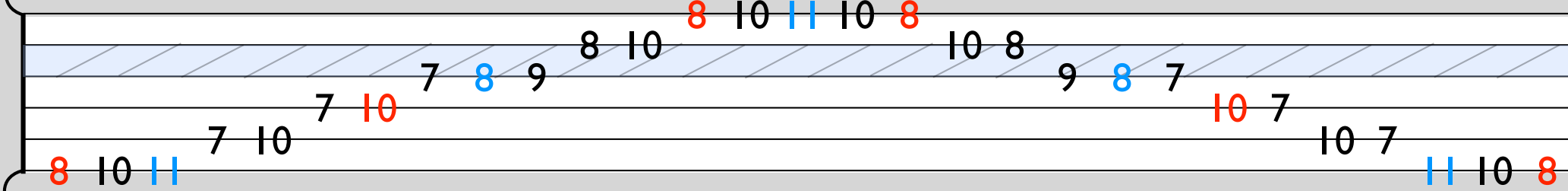

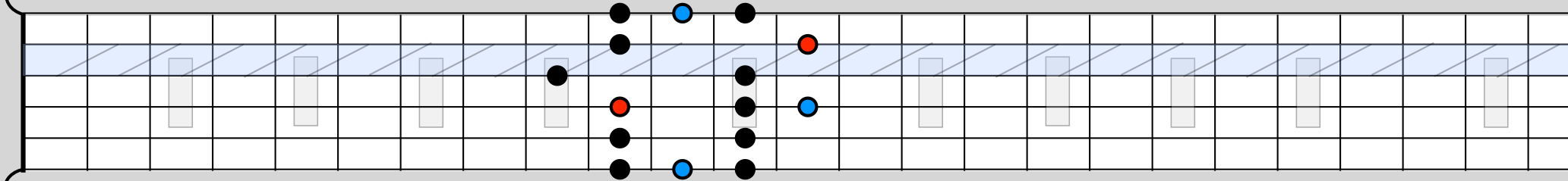


D dorian minor Pentatonic

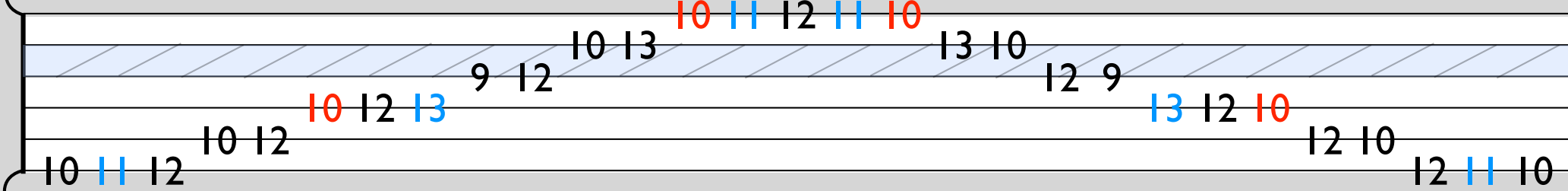

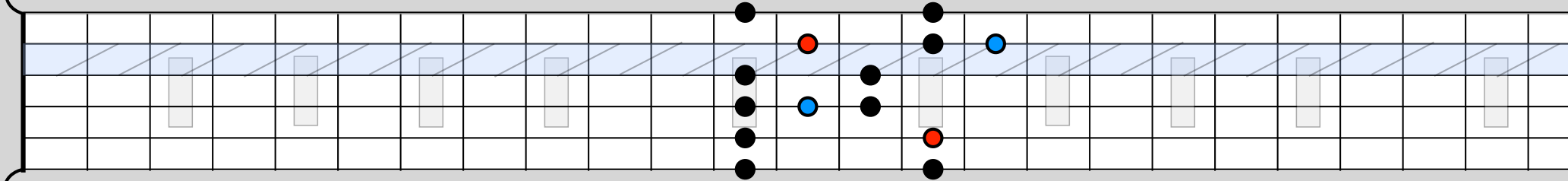


E phrygian minor Pentatonic

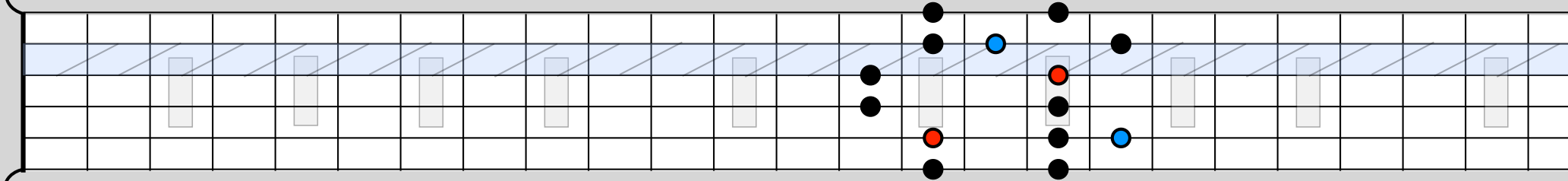


G Mixolydian minor Pentatonic

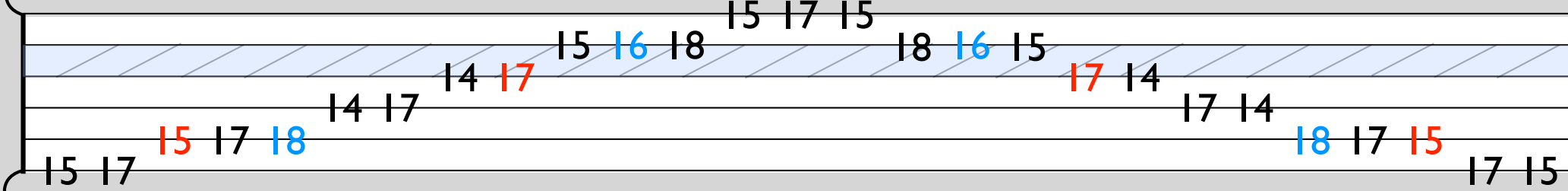
